"The Unquiet Ghost" won the Madeline Dane Ross Award of the Overseas Press Club of America, given to "the best foreign correspondent in any medium showing concern for the human condition. Hochschild's work has also won prizes from the World Affairs Council, the Eugene V. Debs Foundation and the Society of American Travel Writers. An anthology of his shorter pieces, "Finding The Trapdoor: Essays, Portraits, Travels," won the 1998 PEN/Spielvogel-Diamonstein Award for the Art of the
